## **M701 INPUT FILTER RETROFIT**

# I. <u>SCOPE:</u>

To help guide through installing the new input filters on the M701 Zero Air Module.

### II. PARTS:

FL0000015 Input Filter FT0000205 Input Filter Fitting

#### III. TOOLS:

Phillips head screwdriver Flat tip screwdriver Two adjustable wrenches

#### III. PROCEDURE:

- A. Disconnect power from the rear of the M701.
- B. Remove the cover from the M701.
- C. Fold down the rear panel of the M701.
- D. Remove the tubing from the fitting on the rear panel that goes to the input side of the pump.
- E. Remove the fitting from the rear panel.
- F. Install the new fitting (FT0000205) into the rear panel and tighten with the two wrenches.
- G. Reconnect the tube to the new fitting on the rear panel.
- H. Screw the filter into the new fitting on the rear panel.
- I. Replace the cover onto the analyzer, plug the unit in and turn it on.
